Criterium bicycle racing comes to York!


As part of the Element Road Series, the York Cycling Festival is a whole weekend of fun for the whole family.

The Element Road Series is a 13 round cycling series that works towards the common goal of involving more people in racing and creating a positive experience for all. The Series has seen classic cycling events held in different locations from Pickering Brook to Collie Donnybrook and now the historic town of York. With an average of 200 riders participating in each event, we're looking forward to showcasing the best that York has to offer.

Temporary Road Closure of Avon Street, South Street, Lowe Street and Christie Retreat on Sunday 3rd September 2017.

Avon Street, South Street, Lowe Street and Christie Retreat will be temporarily closed to traffic on Sunday, 3rd September from 10am to 2pm as per the map below.

The road is closed for the Town Centre Criterium event to be held as part of the York Cycling Festival. During the closure, traffic controllers will be in attendance on street corners directing traffic.

Traffic management

CycleSport WA have produced a formal Traffic Management Plan with Advanced Traffic Management. Onstreet parking on the circuit will be banned from 8:00am, with the formal road closures in place from 10am to 2:00pm.
