Situated 97km from Perth.

First Settled in 1831, two years after the establishment of the Swan River colony.

Gt Southern Hwy, heading towards Beverley

One of the few remaining permanent pools of the Avon River, just 11kms south of York. A boardwalk and viewing tower will take you right to the river-pool and close to nature without disturbing the environment. BBQ and Public Toilets available.

Note: boardwalk currently closed for repairs.

(75) Mount Brown Lookout

Pioneer Drive, York

Mount Brown, which is 342m above sea level, is within five minutes of the York town site. Mt Brown provides a beautiful 360-degree panoramic view of York and its surrounds. It is also a wonderful setting for a picnic or barbecue.

164 Avon Terrace, take the path next to the RSL Hall. The RSL welcomes visitors to York to visit their beautiful rose garden and picnic area. A great place to sit with your picnic basket or just to meditate in the quiet peaceful gardens.

(62) RV Parking FREE for 24 hours at Avon Park

Low Street, York (Toilets: Close 7pm to 7am)

The perfect picnic spot right on the banks of the Avon River. Features kid's playground, free gas barbeques, shady trees, picnic tables, toilet facilities and **RV dump point**. Take 1.5 km stroll from the Suspension Bridge along the Avon Walk Trail down to Mile Pool and Water Street.

(56) Sandalwood Yards

Avon Terrace, York

Sandalwood was one of the early Colony's major exports, and hundreds of cutters made a living bush felling the wood which was brought to this yard. It was stacked upright in the open to dry and then carted to Fremantle to be shipped overseas. **Local potter in work, open Sat 1pm-5pm and Sun 11am-5pm.**

(60) Tipperary School Museum originally located on Tipperary Farm, 8km north of York, this was one of the very few remaining single teacher school houses in the district. The building was dismantled brick by brick and re-erected at the Sandalwood Yards by a team of dedicated volunteers and members of The York Society.

York's original swinging bridge was first opened in 1888 after petitioning from residents for a footbridge. In 1896 the bridge was lengthened and moved to its current position and has been rebuilt many times due to flood water damage.
