

York is the oldest inland European settlement in Western Australia, situated on the Avon River on Ballardong Noongar land.



After thousands of years of occupation by Ballardong Noongar people, the area was first settled by Europeans in 1831, a town established in 1835 and the first buildings erected in 1836.

The region was important throughout the 19th century for sheep and grain farming and was renowned for its sandalwood trade. York boomed during the gold rush as the last rail stop before the walk to the goldfields.

York continues to attract visitors to its heritage buildings, annual festivals and natural environment.

Hot spot information is seasonal and the Visitor Centre team can provide the best locations for viewing. We love and care about our natural environment and ask you do the same. Tread lightly, leave only footprints and only take photos.
