History and Heritage

York is the oldest inland European settlement in Western Australia, situated on the Gogulyar Bilya/Avon River on Ballardong Noongar land.

After thousands of years of occupation by Ballardong Noongar people, the area was first settled by Europeans in 1831, a town established in 1835 and the first buildings erected in 1836.

The region was important throughout the 19th century for sheep and grain farming and was renowned for its sandalwood trade. York boomed during the gold rush as the last rail stop before the walk to the goldfields.

York continues to attract visitors to its heritage buildings, annual festivals and natural environment.

Day 2: History & Panoramic Views

Have a delicious breakfast and great coffee at one of York's many cafés, then visit the Swing Bridge for a scenic walk over the Gogulyar Bilya/Avon River.

Head back to the York Town Hall for a deeper dive into its history.

Afternoon

Drive up Wongborel/Mt Brown lookout for 360-degree panoramic views of York and the Avon Valley. A great spot for photography, fresh air, and unwinding in nature.

Evening

Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant or pub.

Day 3: Final Stops & Return to Perth

Morning

Enjoy another hearty breakfast at one of York's cafés, then visit The Sock Factory for unique, locally made wool products.

Take a final walk along Avon Terrace's shopping precinct or a peaceful stroll along the Gogulyar Bilya/Avon River.



Midday and early afternoon

Check-out of your accommodation and pick up a coffee for the road before hitting the Great Southern Highway towards Perth. About 15kms out of York, stop at Mount Observation for a short bushwalk through native flora and more breathtaking views.



Afternoon

Arrive back in Perth feeling relaxed and rejuvenated, with a pocketful of memories.

Autumn (March - May) for cooler weather & beautiful foliage.

Winter/Spring (August - October) for wildflowers & canola fields.

TOP SELFIE SPOTS:

York Town Hall
Built in 1911, this iconic landmark has impressive architectural features both inside and out. Use the beautiful jarrah staircase to emphasise elegance in your photographic compositions.

Wongborel/Mt Brown
A great spot to take a selfie, with spectacular views across the valley.

Suspension Bridge
This unique structure is the ideal backdrop for your selfie.

York is fast becoming a must-visit destination for film lovers and tourists alike! With its stunning heritage streetscapes, rolling countryside, and warm country charm, it's no wonder this historic town has been chosen as the backdrop for major film productions.

Hollywood Comes to York

"The Twelve" Season 2 (2024) - This gripping crime drama chose York as one of its key filming locations, transforming the Town of Tunkwell and turning the York Town Hall into the Tunkwell Court House. The series also earned major acclaim, with Sam Neill winning the 2025 Logie Award for Best Actor for his performance.

"Runt" (2024) - This heartwarming family film was shot right here in York. The town of Upson Downs comes alive with many film location spots to visit. *Runt* became one of the top three highest-grossing Australian films of 2024, and at the WA Screen Culture Awards it received four nominations, winning for Outstanding Achievement in Writing, Production Design, and Original Music. Can you spot which beloved York businesses appear on screen?

"The Travellers" (2025) - Directed by the legendary Bruce Beresford, this emotional Australian drama follows a successful stage designer returning to his hometown to farewell his dying mother - only to be swept into family tensions, old friendships, and past romances. Filmed across Western Australia, the production features striking York locations including Wongborel/Mount Brown, the Avon River, and the Castle Hotel. Starring Australian icons Luke Bracey, Bryan Brown and Susie Porter, *The Travellers* adds another standout chapter to York's growing film legacy.

York Residency Museum

A visit to the award-winning Residency Museum offers a captivating glimpse into the region's rich heritage. Professionally curated exhibits highlight a vibrant array of themes, sharing engaging stories of local people and places. Built in the 1850's, it stands as the last surviving structure of York's Convict Depot and served for a time from 1925 as the maternity hospital for the area.

Suspension Bridge Avon Park

York's original suspension footbridge first opened in 1888, linking east and west. It survived major floods in 1891 and 1893, was widened in 1894, and further lengthened and moved to its current position in 1896. Today, it remains a historic landmark, attracting visitors with its unique structure and photo opportunities.

Wongborel/Mt Brown is 342m above sea level and within five minutes drive from the York town site. The lookout provides 360 degree panoramic views of York, with picnic seating and barbecues a few metres below.

The York Branch of The Wildflower Society of Western Australia work to maintain the bushland garden for locals and visitors to enjoy any time of the year, with September to November the peak time for flowering. 



WILDFLOWERS

York is fortunate to have many reserves where wildflowers are protected. Most include orchids and wildflowers and will bloom from July until mid-October (times may vary each season). Hot spot information is seasonal and the Visitor Centre team can provide the best locations for viewing. We love and care about our natural environment and ask you do the same. Tread lightly, leave only footprints and only take photos.

York is well known in the cycling community for downhill mountain biking, cross country trails and for the more adventurous its open road cycle routes. Winter and Wildflower season (July - September) are particularly popular times for riders.


