BENEFITS OF ATTENDING THIS WORKSHOP:

- Gain an understanding of what carbon farming means for farmers and land managers;
- Learn how to calculate greenhouse gas emissions and carbon storage for your property;

- Understand the obligations and risks involved in establishing and running a project.

The workshop will include a worked example of an on-farm 'carbon account' and opportunity to ask questions about your own production data, with time allocated to explore what changes mean to your emissions intensity.
