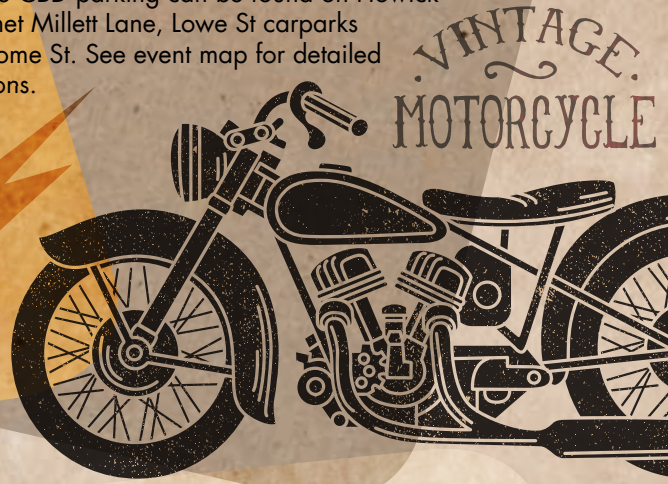
Parking

Vintage Hill Climb

The Vintage Hill Climb will be a spectacle of riders and their machines against the mountain, with a selection of vintage and classic machines from the 1920s up to the late 1970s. Riders will be given two timed passes and will need to replicate the next three timed passes as close to their nominated time as possible. The event is run by enthusiasts from the Western Australian vintage motorcycle community.

Designated spectator areas will be available to view the competition action from 9am. The road will be closed to all traffic with a courtesy bus stopping at the York Cemetery Carpark. See map for other bus stop locations.

Food and refreshments will be available on-site. A folding chair and sun protection is recommended.

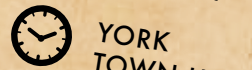
